COMMENCEMENT OF ACT

1956 No. 1065 (C. 5)

The Administration of Justice Act (Commencement) Order, 1956

Made - - - - - 10th July, 1956

Whereas it is provided by subsection (4) of section 57 of the Administration of Justice Act, 1956(a), that the provisions of that Act, other than Part V thereof, section 55 thereof and the First Schedule thereto, shall come into force on such day as the Lord Chancellor may appoint by Order made by statutory instrument and that he may appoint different days for different purposes:

Now, therefore, I, David, Viscount Kilmuir, Lord High Chancellor of Great Britain, in exercise of the power conferred by the said subsection (4), hereby make the following Order:—

1. The provisions of the Administration of Justice Act, 1956, set out in the Schedule hereto, and the repeals consequential on those provisions, shall come into force on the sixteenth day of July, 1956.

2. This Order may be cited as the Administration of Justice Act (Commencement) Order, 1956.
