WILD BIRDS

The Wild Birds (Sundays) Order, 1956

Made - - - - 17th August, 1956

Coming into Operation 1st September, 1956

In pursuance of the power conferred upon me by subsections (2) and (5) of section two of the Protection of Birds Act, 1954(a), I hereby make the following Order:—

1. The administrative counties of Brecknock, Cardigan, Denbigh and Merioneth shall be prescribed areas for the purpose of subsection (2) of section two of the Protection of Birds Act, 1954.

2. This Order may be cited as the Wild Birds (Sundays) Order, 1956, and shall come into operation on the first day of September, 1956.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

Under section 2 (2) of the Protection of Birds Act, 1954, any wild bird included in the Third Schedule to the Act may be killed or taken in England or Wales on any day outside the close season for that bird except on Sundays in areas prescribed by order of the Secretary of State. This Order prescribes for this purpose the administrative counties of Brecknock, Cardigan, Denbigh and Merioneth, and accordingly it will be an offence to kill or take or attempt to kill or take any wild bird included in the Third Schedule to the Act on Sundays in any of those areas.
