The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas it is provided by section 22 of the Land Powers (Defence) Act. 1958(a), that Her Majesty may by Order in Council appoint a day when the section (which provides that the General Claims Tribunal constituted under the Compensation (Defence) Act, 1939(b), shall cease to exist, and its jurisdiction be transferred to the Lands Tribunal in England and appropriate tribunals in Scotland and Northern Ireland) shall come into force:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

- 1. Section 22 of the Land Powers (Defence) Act, 1958, shall come into force on the 27th day of October, 1958.
- 2. This Order may be cited as the General Claims Tribunal (Transfer Date) Order, 1958.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order fixes the 27th October, 1958, as the date when section 22 of the Land Powers (Defence) Act, 1958, comes into force. Section 22 abolishes the General Claims Tribunal and transfers its jurisdiction to the Lands Tribunal in England and appropriate tribunals in Scotland and Northern Ireland.
