**The Visiting Forces Act (Application to Colonies)
(Amendment No. 2) Order, 1959**

Made - - - - 20th November, 1959

Coming into Operation 15th December, 1959

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 20th day of November, 1959

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred on Her by subsection (1) of section 15 of the Visiting Forces Act, 1952(a), is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

Citation, construction, revocation and commencement

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Visiting Forces Act (Application to Colonies) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1959, and shall be construed as one with the Visiting Forces Act (Application to Colonies) Orders, 1954 to 1959(b).

(2) The Visiting Forces Act (Application to Colonies) Orders, 1954 to 1959, and this Order may be cited together as the Visiting Forces Act (Application to Colonies) Orders, 1954 to 1959.

(3) Subsection (2) of section 1 of the Visiting Forces Act (Application to Colonies) (Amendment) Order, 1959, is revoked.

(4) This Order shall come into operation on such date as the Governor of St. Helena may, by Proclamation published in the St. Helena Government Gazette, appoint.

Amendment of Visiting Forces Act (Application to Colonies) Order, 1954.

2. The Visiting Forces Act (Application to Colonies) Order, 1954, is amended by inserting in their appropriate alphabetical order the words "Ascension Island" in the list of territories mentioned in the First Schedule thereto.
