The Charities (Exception of Voluntary Schools from Registration) Regulations, 1960

Made - - - 15th December, 1960

Laid before Parliament 22nd December, 1960

Coming into Operation 1st January, 1961

The Minister of Education, in pursuance of subsection (4) of section 4 and section 43 of the Charities Act, 1960(a), hereby makes the following regulations:—

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Charities (Exception of Voluntary Schools from Registration) Regulations, 1960, and shall come into operation on the first day of January, 1961.
- 2. All voluntary schools, within the meaning of the Education Acts, 1944 to 1959, being charities and having no permanent endowment other than the premises of, or connected with, the school, are hereby excepted from the duty to be registered under subsection (2) of section 4 of the Charities Act, 1960.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These regulations except from the obligation to register those voluntary schools which, being charities, have no permanent endowment other than their premises.
