CHARITIES

The Charities (Exception of Certain Charities for Boy Scouts and Girl Guides from Registration) Regulations, 1961

Made - - - 1st June, 1961 Laid before Parliament 8th June, 1961 Coming into Operation 22nd June, 1961

The Minister of Education, in pursuance of subsection (4) of section 4 and section 43 of the Charities Act, 1960(a), hereby makes the following regulations:—

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Charities (Exception of Certain Charities for Boy Scouts and Girl Guides from Registration) Regulations, 1961, and shall come into operation on the 22nd day of June, 1961.
- 2. Charities comprising funds, not being permanent endowments, belonging to units, or to trustees for units, of the Boy Scouts Association or the Girl Guides Association, which are being accumulated for the purposes of the unit and which produce an income of more than £15 a year, are hereby excepted from the duty to be registered under subsection (2) of section 4 of the Charities Act, 1960.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These regulations except from the obligation to register funds, not representing permanent endowments, which are being accumulated for the purpose of local units of the Boy Scouts Association and the Girl Guides Association and which produce an income of more than £15 a year.
