## NATIONAL INSURANCE

**The National Insurance (Modification of Superannuation Provisions) (Assistant Clerks of Assize) Regulations, 1961**

<i>Made</i> - - - - -	7th June, 1961
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	13th June, 1961
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	15th June, 1961

The Lord Chancellor, being the appropriate Minister determined by the Treasury under sub-section (4) of section 69 of the National Insurance Act, 1946(a), in relation to the superannuation provisions hereinafter referred to, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by the said sub-section as extended by section 15 of the National Insurance Act, 1959(b) hereby makes the following Regulations:—

*Commencement and Citation*

1. These Regulations shall come into force on the fifteenth day of June, 1961 and may be cited as the National Insurance (Modification of Superannuation Provisions) (Assistant Clerks of Assize) Regulations, 1961.

*Interpretation*

2—(1) Any reference in these Regulations to the provisions of any enactment shall be construed, except where the context otherwise requires, as a reference to those provisions as amended or re-enacted by any subsequent enactment.

(2) The Interpretation Act, 1889(c), shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

*Pensionable Age of Women*

3. Notwithstanding anything contained in section 128 of the Supreme Court of Judicature (Consolidation) Act, 1925(d) as applied to Assistants to Clerks of Assize by section 1 of the Supreme Court of Judicature (Circuit Officers) Act, 1946(e) and section 5 of the Criminal Justice Administration Act, 1956(f) there may be paid to any such Assistant to a Clerk of Assize, being a woman, a retirement pension, provided she has attained the age of fifty and has served not less than fifteen years as such an Assistant.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)*

These Regulations permit the payment of a pension to a woman Assistant Clerk of Assize at the age of sixty, instead of at sixty-five, as was formerly the case, provided she has served not less than fifteen years.
