## PENSIONS

**The Superannuation (National Assistance Board) Transfer  
(Amendment) Rules, 1961**

<i>Made</i> - - - - -	21st July, 1961
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	26th July, 1961
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	27th July, 1961

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by Section 2 of the Superannuation Act, 1957(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Rules:—

1. Rule 1 of the Superannuation (National Assistance Board) Transfer Rules, 1959(b), shall be amended as follows:—

- (1) in subparagraph (a) of paragraph (1) of the said Rule there shall be substituted for the words "first day of May nineteen hundred and thirty-seven" the words "first day of October nineteen hundred and sixty";
- (2) in subparagraph (a) of paragraph (1) of the said Rule there shall be substituted for the words "the Unemployment Assistance Board" the words "the Unemployment Assistance Board, the Assistance Board, the National Assistance Board,";
- (3) in subparagraph (b) of paragraph (1) of the said Rule there shall be substituted for the words "sixth day of July" the words "nineteenth day of October";
- (4) in subparagraph (d) of paragraph (1) of the said Rule there shall be deleted the words "in pensionable employment".

2. The Interpretation Act, 1889(c), shall apply to the interpretation of these Rules as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. These Rules may be cited as the Superannuation (National Assistance Board) Transfer (Amendment) Rules, 1961, and shall come into operation on the 27th day of July, nineteen hundred and sixty-one.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This Note is not part of the Rules, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)*

The Rules amend the Superannuation (National Assistance Board) Transfer Rules, 1959, which provide for service (not being service before the 1st January, 1919 or before age 18) with local authorities or the local Pension Committee in London of staff who were taken into the Civil Service on work which was taken over by the Central Government from former Public Assistance Authorities and the London Old Age Pension Committee to be reckoned on certain conditions as unestablished civil service for the purposes of the Superannuation Acts.

2. The Rules—

- (i) extend the definition of persons so taken over in an unestablished capacity from local authorities in England and Wales to include a group who were taken over during 1940, and several groups who have been taken over in recent years when the Board have taken over local authorities Reception Centres, the latest such transfer occurring on the 30th September, 1960 ;
- (ii) extend the definition of persons taken over in an unestablished capacity from local authorities in Scotland to include a group so taken over in 1948, the latest such transfer occurring on the 18th October, 1948 ;
- (iii) extend the definition of persons taken over in an established capacity to include a person who was taken over on the 5th July, 1948, from the employment of a local authority which was not pensionable employment.
