PENSIONS

The Superannuation (Transfer of Hostels Staff) Rules, 1962

Made - - - - 24th January, 1962 Laid before Parliament 29th January, 1962 Coming into Operation 30th January, 1962

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 2 of the Superannuation Act, 1957(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Rules:—

1.—(1) Where a person was taken into the civil service of the State as an officer of the Ministry of Supply—

(a) on the first day of April, nineteen hundred and fifty-four, after having been employed by Holiday Fellowship Limited at Grazeley Green Hostel, Reading, Berkshire; or

- (b) on the first day of July, nineteen hundred and fifty-four, after having been employed by the Joint Committee of the Young Men's Christian Association and the Young Women's Christian Association at Highways Hostel, Chorley, Lancashire, or Frobisher Hall Hostel, Swynnerton, Staffordshire; or
- (c) on the first day of October, nineteen hundred and fifty-five, after having been employed by the Co-operative Holidays Association at Geraldine Road Hostel, Malvern, Worcestershire.

and his employment by the body by whom he was so employed was, in the opinion of the Treasury, of the same nature and for the same purpose as his employment in the service of the State, his service in employment by that body before the date on which he was taken into the service of the State shall be reckoned for the purposes of the Superannuation Acts, 1834 to 1960, as employment in an unestablished capacity within the meaning of section 3 of the Superannuation Act, 1935(b).

- (2) These Rules shall not have effect so as to authorise an increase in an annual superannuation allowance or pension so far as the allowance or pension is payable in respect of a period before the twenty-first day of November, nineteen hundred and fifty-seven.
- 2. The Interpretation Act, 1889(c), shall apply for the interpretation of these Rules as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. These Rules may be cited as the Superannuation (Transfer of Hostels Staff) Rules, 1962, and shall come into operation on the 30th day of January, nineteen hundred and sixty-two.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Rules, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Rules relate to members of the staff of certain hostels provided for workers at Government establishments. The hostels were formerly administered, and the staff were employed, by certain bodies which received grants out of monies provided by Parliament. On certain dates in 1954 and 1955 the administration of the hostels was taken over by the Ministry of Supply, and members of the staff were taken into the Civil Service as officers of that Ministry.

The Rules provide for these persons' service (after the age of 18) with the bodies which formerly administered the hostels to be reckoned as unestablished service for the purposes of the Superannuation Acts.
