LOCAL GOVERNMENT, ENGLAND AND WALES

The Schools (Amending) Regulations 1963

Made - - - - - 26th August 1963

Laid before Parliament 2nd September 1963

Coming into Operation 3rd September 1963

The Minister of Education, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 3(4) of the Local Government Act 1958(a), hereby makes the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Schools (Amending) Regulations 1963 and shall come into operation on the 3rd day of September 1963.

2. Regulation 15 of the Schools Regulations 1959(b) (which prescribes the conditions under which pupils may be entered for external examinations) is hereby amended as follows:—

(a) the omission of the word “either”;

(b) the insertion as paragraph (a) of the following paragraph:—

“(a) he has completed or is about to complete his fifth school year of a course of secondary education; or”

(c) the re-lettering of the existing paragraphs as (b) and (c).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These regulations amend the conditions under which school pupils may be entered for public examinations. They may now be entered for an examination if they have completed or are about to complete their fifth year of secondary education.
