PART VII

BEAM SCALES AND BALANCES

Principles of construction

72. No beam scale shall—

- (a) if constructed with swan-neck ends, be of a capacity of 7 pounds or less or have a beam under 16 inches in length;
- (b) be fitted with loaded weight pans;
- (c) if of a capacity of less than 2 hundredweight, be fitted with wooden scale boards.
