**Act of Sederunt (Betting, Gaming and Lotteries Act Appeals
Amendment) 1966**

Made - - - 5th October 1966

Coming into Operation 24th October 1966

The Lords of Council and Session, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by paragraph 24 of the First Schedule to the Betting, Gaming and Lotteries Act 1963(a) and of all other powers competent to them in that behalf, do hereby enact and declare as follows:—

1. The Act of Sederunt (Betting, Gaming and Lotteries Act Appeals) 1965(b) is hereby amended by adding after the words “Clerk to the appropriate authority” occurring in section 2 thereof, a comma followed by the words:— “to the Collector of Customs and Excise for the area where the premises in respect of which the appropriate application was made are situated”, and by adding a comma after the said additional words.

2. This Act of Sederunt may be cited as the Act of Sederunt (Betting, Gaming and Lotteries Act Appeals Amendment) 1966, and shall come into operation on 24th October 1966.

And the Lords appoint this Act of Sederunt to be inserted in the Books of Sederunt.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Act of Sederunt.)

This Act of Sederunt amends the procedure for Appeals to the Sheriff Court under paragraph 24 of the First Schedule to the Betting, Gaming and Lotteries Act 1963, by providing that a copy of the initial writ shall be sent to the local Collector of Customs and Excise.
