**The Importation of Plants and Plant Produce (Health)
(Great Britain) (Amendment) Order 1966**

<i>Made</i> - - - -	13th October 1966
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	25th October 1966
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	26th October 1966

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretary of State, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in them respectively by section 1 of the Destructive Insects Act 1877(a) as extended by section 1 of the Destructive Insects and Pests Act 1907(b) and amended by section 1 of the Destructive Insects and Pests Act 1927(c) and of every other power enabling them in that behalf, order as follows:—

Citation, extent and commencement

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Importation of Plants and Plant Produce (Health) (Great Britain) (Amendment) Order 1966 and the Importation of Plants and Plant Produce (Health) (Great Britain) Order 1965(d) (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Order”) and this Order may be cited together as the Importation of Plants and Plant Produce (Health) (Great Britain) Orders 1965 and 1966.

(2) This Order shall apply to England and Wales and Scotland and shall come into operation on 26th October 1966.

Amendment of principal Order

2. The principal Order is hereby amended by adding the word “Malta” between the words “Greece” and “Spain” where they appear in the second column, opposite item (2) in the first column, of Part IA of Schedule 1.
