The European Free Trade Association (Origin of Goods) (Amendment No. 3) Regulations 1966

Made	20th December 1966
Laid before the House of Commons	30th December 1966
Coming into Operation	31st December 1966

The Board of Trade, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by section 1(1) of the European Free Trade Association Act 1960(a), hereby make the following Regulations:—

1. The European Free Trade Association (Origin of Goods) Regulations 1964 (b), as amended (c), shall have effect as if—

in Schedule 2, after the second entry in relation to tariff heading 59.17, there were inserted the following entry:—

" Tariff heading and description

*59.17. Fabrics (other than woven textile felts) of a kind commonly used in machinery for making or finishing cellulosic pulp, paper or paperboard, including such fabrics in tubular or endless form. Qualifying process Manufacture from monofil of polyester (ex 51.02); or from materials not falling in Chapters 50 to 62."

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the European Free Trade Association (Origin of Goods) (Amendment No. 3) Regulations 1966 and shall come into operation on 31st December 1966.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations further amend the European Free Trade Association (Origin of Goods) Regulations 1964. They provide that the fabrics specified in regulation 1 may be eligible for E.F.T.A. tariff treatment if they have undergone in the E.F.T.A. area the process specified in that regulation.
