1966 No. 1588**FACTORIES****The Docks, etc. General Register Order 1966**

Made- - - - - 19th December 1966
Coming into Operation 9th January 1967

The Minister of Labour by virtue of the powers conferred on him by sections 140(1) and 180(3) of the Factories Act 1961(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Docks, etc. General Register Order 1966 and shall come into operation on 9th January 1967.

(2) The Order prescribing a form of general register for use in the case of docks, wharves, quays and certain warehouses made by the Minister of Labour on 11th May 1960 is hereby revoked.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament, and as if this Order and the Order hereby revoked were Acts of Parliament.

3. The general register required by section 140(1) of the Factories Act 1961 (as that subsection is applied by section 125 of that Act to docks, etc.) to be kept in every factory (or in such place outside the factory as may be approved by the inspector for the district) shall in the case of docks, wharves, quays and the warehouses, lines and sidings to which provisions of that Act apply by virtue of section 125 thereof, be in the form set out in the Schedule to this Order and shall contain the particulars therein specified.

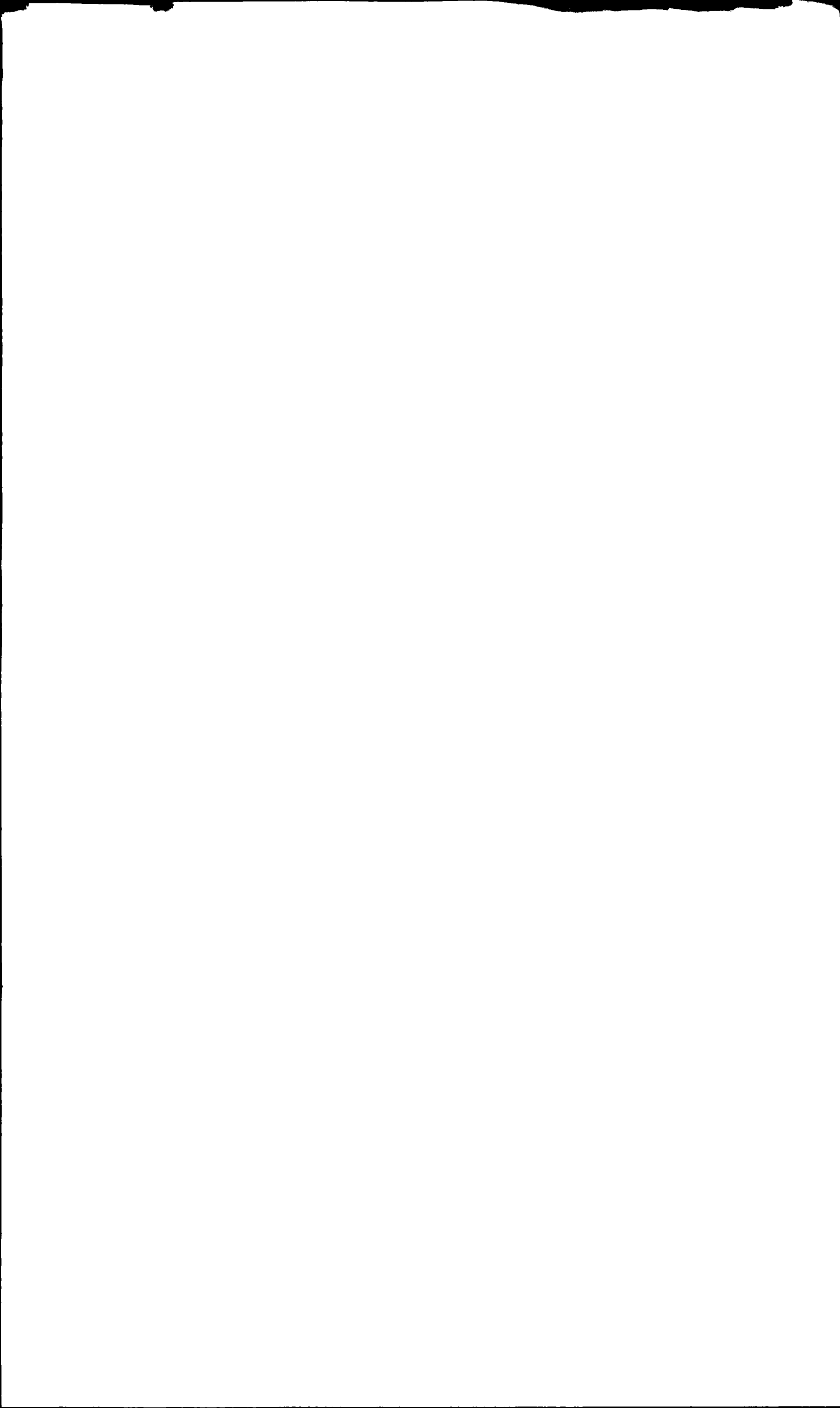

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order prescribes the form of general register required by section 140(1) of the Factories Act 1961 to be kept in every factory (or in such place outside the factory as may be approved by the factory inspector for the district) and the particulars to be entered therein, for use in the case of any dock, wharf, quay, warehouse, line or siding to which section 125 of that Act applies.

The general register prescribed by this Order is in substitution for that prescribed by the Order of the Minister of Labour dated 11th May 1960 which is revoked.
