# The Ministry of Social Security Act 1966 (Commencement) Order 1966

Made - - - 8th August 1966

The Minister of Social Security, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 40 of the Ministry of Social Security Act 1966(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

- 1. The day appointed for the coming into operation of any provision of the Ministry of Social Security Act 1966 specified in column 1 of the Schedule to this order, so far as that provision relates to any subject matter specified in column 2 of that Schedule, shall be the date specified in column 3 of that Schedule in relation to that subject matter.
- 2. This order may be cited as the Ministry of Social Security Act 1966 (Commencement) Order 1966.
