# The Naval Medical Compassionate Fund (Amendment) Order 1967

Made - - - - - Coming into Operation

10th October 1967

1st November 1967

At the Court at Balmoral, the 10th day of October 1967

#### Present.

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in pursuance of section 1 of the Naval Medical Compassionate Fund Act 1915(a) as amended by the Defence (Transfer of Functions) (No. 1) Order 1964(b) and of all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

- 1.—(1) This Order shall come into operation on 1st November 1967 and may be cited as the Naval Medical Compassionate Fund (Amendment) Order 1967.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 2. The Order in Council dated 28th July 1915(d), whereby Standing Orders and Regulations for the Constitution and Government of the Naval Medical Compassionate Fund were approved, shall be amended as follows:—
  - (1) Article 2 of the said Standing Orders and Regulations shall be revoked and there shall be substituted the following:—
    - "2. The Person holding the Office, for the time being, of Medical Director General (Naval) shall be the President and a Trustee of the Fund. The Persons holding the Offices, for the time being, of Accountant General of the Navy and of Director of Greenwich Hospital, respectively, shall be Trustees of the Fund."
  - (2) Article 11 of the said Standing Orders and Regulations shall be revoked and there shall be substituted the following:—
    - "11. The Honorary Secretary shall be an Officer appointed by the Medical Director General (Naval) from among the Officers serving on his staff and shall be reimbursed out of the income of the Fund for all proper expenses incurred by him in performing the duties of his office, including the expense of clerical assistance."
