FOOD HYGIENE

The Food (Preparation and Distribution of Meat) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1967

Made - - - - - 11th October 1967

Laid before Parliament 18th October 1967

Coming into Operation 19th October 1967

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by sections 13 and 56 of the Food and Drugs (Scotland) Act 1956(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, having consulted with such organisations as appear to me to be representative of interests substantially affected by these regulations and after reference to the Scottish Food Hygiene Council under section 25 of that Act, I hereby make the following regulations:—

- 1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Food (Preparation and Distribution of Meat) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1967 and shall come into operation on 19th October 1967.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 2. The Food (Preparation and Distribution of Meat) (Scotland) Regulations 1963(c) shall be amended as follows—
 - (a) in regulation 45(2), for the words "hot or cold water" there shall be substituted the words "hot and cold water";
 - (b) in regulation 54, in the definition of "meat", for the words "article of food in which" there shall be substituted the words "article of food of which":
 - (c) in regulation 56, for the words "From and after such date as the Secretary of State may appoint, being a date not earlier than four years after the coming into operation of this Part of these regulations," there shall be substituted the words "From and after 1st July 1968,";
 - (d) in regulation 59, for the words "animal or live bird" there shall be substituted the words "live animal or bird".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations, made under section 13 of the Food and Drugs (Scotland) Act 1956, and applying to Scotland only, fix 1st July 1968 as the date from which unwrapped meat shall not be transported by road otherwise than in a meat compartment or a meat container, and make certain drafting amendments to the Food (Preparation and Distribution of Meat) (Scotland) Regulations 1963.
