**The Wireless Telegraphy Act 1967  
(Appointed Day) Order 1967**

<i>Coming into Operation</i>		1st January 1968

I, the Right Honourable Edward Watson Short, M.P., Her Majesty's Postmaster General, by virtue of the power vested in me by sections 1, 6 and 13 of the Wireless Telegraphy Act 1967(a) and of every other power enabling me hereby make the following order :—

1. The appointed day for the purposes of sections 1, 2 and 3 of the said Act shall be the 1st January 1968.

2. This Order may be cited as the Wireless Telegraphy Act 1967 (Appointed Day) Order 1967, and shall come into operation on the 1st January 1968.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

The Order specifies the appointed day by reference to which television dealers are required, (a) to register with the Postmaster General (under section 1 of the Wireless Telegraphy Act 1967), (b) to notify to the Postmaster General and to record certain particulars of transactions in television sets (under section 2 of that Act), and (c) to furnish to the Postmaster General additional information about certain contracts for the credit-sale, hiring or hire-purchase of television sets (under section 3 of that Act).
