The Pensions (Polish Forces) Scheme (Extension) Order 1967

The Minister of Social Security, with the consent of the Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred upon her by section 1 of the Polish Resettlement Act 1947(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following order :—

Citation. interpretation and commencement

1. This order, which may be cited as the Pensions (Polish Forces) Scheme (Extension) Order 1967, shall be read as one with the Pensions (Polish Forces) Scheme 1964(b) (hereinafter referred to as "the Scheme") and shall come into operation on 22nd March 1967.

Extension of the Scheme

2. For the purposes of Article 14(1) of the Scheme (duration of the Scheme, etc.) the extended period of five years from 26th March 1967 is hereby specified, and accordingly payments under the Scheme shall be limited to such as fall due for payment before 27th March 1972.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

The Pensions (Polish Forces) Scheme 1964 provides for the payment of war pensions and allowances to certain members of the Polish forces, their widows and dependants. This order extends the life of the Scheme, which would otherwise expire on 26th March 1967, until 26th March 1972.
