The Exempt Charities Order 1967

Made - - - - *24th May 1967*
Coming into Operation *1st June 1967*

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 24th day of May 1967

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in pursuance of paragraph (c) of Schedule 2 to the Charities Act 1960, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1. The universities and other institution specified in the Schedule to this Order are hereby declared to be exempt charities for the purposes of the Charities Act 1960.
2. This Order may be cited as the Exempt Charities Order 1967 and shall come into operation on 1st June 1967.
