## CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

**The European Free Trade Association (Drawback) (Amendment)  
Regulations 1968**

<i>Made</i> - - - - -	24th January 1968
<i>Laid before the House of Commons</i>	31st January 1968
<i>Coming into Operation</i> - -	1st February 1968

The Board of Trade, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by section 2 of the European Free Trade Association Act 1960 (a), hereby make the following Regulations:—

1. The European Free Trade Association (Drawback) Regulations 1966 (b) shall have effect as if in regulation 3(h) “£30” were substituted for “£25”.
2. The Interpretation Act 1889 (c) shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. These Regulations may be cited as the European Free Trade Association (Drawback) (Amendment) Regulations 1968 and shall come into operation on 1st February 1968.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)*

The European Free Trade Association (Drawback) Regulations 1966 prescribe circumstances in which E.F.T.A. goods may be treated as not eligible for E.F.T.A. treatment when imported into the United Kingdom. They do not apply to goods whose f.o.b. value in the country of exportation does not exceed a specified amount. These Regulations increase that amount from £25 to £30.
