## The Fees for Registration of Nursing and Residential Homes (Variation) Order 1968

Made	24th January 1968
Laid before Parliament	31st January 1968
Coming into Operation	1st April 1968

The Minister of Health, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 35(2) of and Part II of Schedule 3 to the Local Government Act 1966(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

1. This order may be cited as the Fees for Registration of Nursing and Residential Homes (Variation) Order 1968, and shall come into operation on 1st April 1968.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. In the following enactments (which specify the fees payable on an application for registration of any person proposing to carry on, respectively, a nursing home, a mental nursing home, a disabled persons' or old persons' home, or a residential home for mentally disordered persons), namely—

- (a) section 187(2) of the Public Health Act 1936(c) (including that subsection as applied by section 14 of the Mental Health Act 1959(d)) and
- (b) section 37(2) of the National Assistance Act 1948(e) (including that subsection as applied by section 19 of the Mental Health Act 1959).

for the words "a fee of five shillings" there shall be substituted the words "a fee of one pound".

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order increases from five shillings to one pound the fee which must accompany an application for registration by a local authority of a person proposing to carry on—

(i) a nursing home;

(ii) a mental nursing home;

(iii) a disabled persons' or old persons' home;

(iv) a residential home for mentally disordered persons.
