COURT OF SESSION, SCOTLAND

Act of Sederunt (Rules of Court Amendment No. 2) 1968

Made 18th July 1968
Coming into Operation 16th September 1968

The Lords of Council and Session, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by section 16 of the Administration of Justice (Scotland) Act 1933(a) and of all other powers competent to them in that behalf, do hereby enact and declare as follows:-

1. The Rules of Court (b) shall be amended by the addition of a new Section to follow Rule 68 in Chapter I as follows:-

SECTION 10.

Service, intimation and citation

“68A. In any cause in which it shall be competent to serve or intimate any document or to cite any person by recorded delivery, such service, intimation or citation, when made by recorded delivery, shall only be competent and effective by such mode if it is made by recorded delivery first class service”.

2. This Act of Sederunt may be cited as the Act of Sederunt (Rules of Court Amendment No. 2) 1968, and shall come into operation on 16th September 1968.

And the Lords appoint this Act of Sederunt to be inserted in the Books of Sederunt.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Act of Sederunt)

This Act of Sederunt amends the Rules of Court by providing that any service, intimation or citation by recorded delivery shall be made by recorded delivery first class service. It comes into operation on the date appointed by the Postmaster General for the introduction of recorded delivery first class service.
