**The Sheriff Courts and Legal Officers (Scotland) Act 1927
 (Calendar of Confirmations and Inventories) Order 1968**

Made - - - - 31st January 1968

Coming into Operation 2nd February 1968

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 19 of the Sheriff Courts and Legal Officers (Scotland) Act 1927(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby direct as follows:—

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Sheriff Courts and Legal Officers (Scotland) Act 1927 (Calendar of Confirmations and Inventories) Order 1968 and shall come into operation on 2nd February 1968.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. Section 45 of the Sheriff Courts (Scotland) Act 1876(c) shall have effect as if—

(a) for the words from “the name and designation” to “and the value of the estate” there were substituted the words “the surname, forenames and addresses of the deceased as shown in the relative inventory; whether he died testate or intestate; and where and on what date confirmation was granted or the inventory was recorded”;

(b) in proviso (2) thereto, for the words “to every sheriff clerk in Scotland” there were substituted the words “to the sheriff clerk of Lanarkshire at Glasgow”; and

(c) in proviso (3) thereto, the words from “and” to the end of the proviso were deleted.
