In exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 18 and 19 of the Sheriff Courts (Scotland) Act 1907(a), as read with the Secretaries of State Act 1926(b), the Secretary of State hereby orders as follows:—

- 1. This order may be cited as the Sheriff Courts (Ross and Cromarty) Order 1968 and shall come into operation on 1st November 1968.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. Ordinary Courts and Small Debt Courts shall be held at Stornoway on Tuesday of each alternate week.
- 4. This order shall be recorded in the Sheriff Court Books at Stornoway and shall be intimated on the walls of the Sheriff Court House there.
 - 5. The Sheriff Courts (Ross and Cromarty) Order 1957(d) is hereby revoked.
