COURT OF SESSION, SCOTLAND

Act of Sederunt (Rules of Court Amendment No. 3) 1968

Made - - - 4th October 1968
 Coming into Operation 1st November 1968

The Lords of Council and Session, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by section 18 of the Solicitors (Scotland) Act 1933(a) and section 17 of the Solicitors (Scotland) Act 1958(b), and of all other powers competent to them in that behalf, do hereby enact and declare as follows:—

1. The Rules of Court (c) shall be amended by deleting Rule 3 and by substituting a new Rule as follows:—

“3. Registration and enrolment of solicitors

“(a) A register shall be kept by the Registrar of Solicitors under the Solicitors’ (Scotland) Acts 1933 to 1958 for the registration and enrolment of persons admitted as solicitors; and there shall be payable to the said Registrar for each enrolment in the register of solicitors and granting certificate of such enrolment a fee of £4. 4s.

“(b) Every solicitor whose name is for the time being included in the Roll or Register of Solicitors shall pay to the Registrar annually a fee of £1 in respect of the cost of maintaining the Roll or Register, which fee shall be payable on the first day of November in each year, provided that no fee shall be payable by a solicitor for the period between the date of his enrolment and the thirty-first day of October occurring immediately thereafter.”

2. This Act of Sederunt may be cited as the Act of Sederunt (Rules of Court Amendment No. 3) 1968, and shall come into operation on 1st November 1968.

And the Lords appoint this Act of Sederunt to be inserted in the Books of Sederunt.
