The Reserve Forces Act 1966 (Isle of Man) Order 1968

Made - - - 16th October 1968

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 16th day of October 1968

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred on Her by section 25(3) of the Reserve Forces Act 1966(a), is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1. The Reserve Forces Act 1966 shall extend to the Isle of Man subject to the modifications specified in the Schedule to this Order.

2. This Order may be cited as the Reserve Forces Act 1966 (Isle of Man) Order 1968.

SCHEDULE

MODIFICATIONS IN THE RESERVE FORCES ACT 1966 AS EXTENDED
TO THE ISLE OF MAN

1. A reference to the appointed day in any provision of the Act (except section 25(2)) shall be construed as a reference to the appointed day for the purposes of that provision as it applies in the United Kingdom.

2. Sections 18 to 20 shall be omitted.

3. In section 23(1) for the words "section 38(1) of the Interpretation Act 1889" there shall be substituted the words "section 9(1) of the Interpretation Act 1949 (an Act of Tynwald)".

4. Section 25(2) shall be omitted.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order extends the Reserve Forces Act 1966 to the Isle of Man with modifications.
