# The Health Services and Public Health Act 1968 (Commencement No. 2) Order 1968

Made - - - 18th October 1968

The Minister of Health, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 79(2) of the Health Services and Public Health Act 1968(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Health Services and Public Health Act 1968 (Commencement No. 2) Order 1968.
- 2. The appointed day for the coming into force of the provisions of the Health Services and Public Health Act 1968 specified in the Schedule to this Order in their application to England and Wales shall be 1st November 1968.
