The Building Control (Suspension of Control) Order 1968

Made	18th November 1968
Laid before Parliament	19th November 1968
Coming into Operation	20th November 1968

The Minister of Public Building and Works in exercise of his powers under section 8(1)(b)(ii) of the Building Control Act 1966(a) hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Building Control (Suspension of Control) Order 1968 and shall come into operation on 20th November 1968.

2. All work subject to control under the Building Control Act 1966 carried out after the coming into operation of this Order shall, until a further order under section 8(1)(b)(ii) of that Act, be exempt from control under that Act.
