PROFESSIONS SUPPLEMENTARY TO MEDICINE

The Professions Supplementary to Medicine (Registration Rules) (Amendment) Order of Council 1968

Made - - - 13th December 1968

At the Council Chamber, Whitehall, the 13th day of December 1968

By the Lords of Her Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council

Whereas in pursuance of section 2 of the Professions Supplementary to Medicine Act 1960(a) the Council for Professions Supplementary to Medicine has made rules entitled "The Registration (Amendment) Rules 1968":

And whereas by subsection (3) of the said section such rules shall not come into force until confirmed by Order of the Privy Council:

Now, therefore, Their Lordships, having taken the said rules into consideration, are hereby pleased to confirm the same as set out in the Schedule to this Order.

This Order may be cited as the Professions Supplementary to Medicine (Registration Rules) (Amendment) Order of Council 1968.

SCHEDULE

THE REGISTRATION (AMENDMENT) RULES 1968

The Council for Professions Supplementary to Medicine, in exercise of its powers under section 2 of the Professions Supplementary to Medicine Act 1960, hereby makes the following rules:—

1. These rules may be cited as the Registration (Amendment) Rules 1968.
2. The Registration Rules 1962, as scheduled to the Professions Supplementary to Medicine (Registration Rules) Order of Council 1962(b) and as subsequently amended (c), shall be further amended as follows:—
 - (a) Rule 18 shall be deleted.
 - (b) Rule 19 shall be deleted and the following rule shall be substituted therefor:—
 - "19. (i) Registered members of each profession shall, before the dates set out opposite that profession in column 3 of the Schedule, pay a retention fee in respect of the year following that date.
 - (ii) A member of a profession whose name is restored to the Register under Rule 13 shall pay a retention fee in respect of any unexpired portion of the year next ending upon the date set out opposite that profession in column 3 of the Schedule.

(c) There is no amendment which relates expressly to the subject matter of these rules.

- (iii) Payment of any retention fee shall cover retention in a Register for the relevant period of particulars under paragraphs (a), (b), (d) and (e) of Rule 4 of these Rules but shall be increased by £1 per annum for each address registered under paragraph (c) of that Rule.
- (iv) As from the 1st March 1969 the retention fee in respect of a year or any part of a year shall be £2."
