**1968 No. 1988 (C.30)****FUGITIVE CRIMINAL****The Fugitive Offenders Act 1967 (Commencement No. 2)****Order 1968***Made* . . . . *16th December 1968*

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 22 of the Fugitive Offenders Act 1967(a), I hereby make the following Order :—

1. In relation to any country to which Her Majesty is empowered by paragraph (c) of section 2(2) of the Fugitive Offenders Act 1967 (definition of "United Kingdom dependency") to apply the said section 2(2), the said Act shall come into force on 1st January 1969 for the purposes of all the provisions of the Act other than—

(a) the purposes of any provision thereof conferring power on Her Majesty to make an Order in Council, and

(b) the purposes of section 18(2) thereof,  
for which purposes the said Act came into force on 25th August 1967 and 1st September 1967, respectively.

2. This Order may be cited as the Fugitive Offenders Act 1967 (Commencement No. 2) Order 1968.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order provides that the Fugitive Offenders Act 1967 shall come into force on 1st January 1969 for the purposes of all the provisions thereof which have not sooner come into force, so far as they relate to countries and territories outside Her Majesty's dominions in which She has jurisdiction, or over which She extends protection, in right of Her Government in the United Kingdom.
