PROBATION AND AFTER-CARE

The Probation (Conditions of Service) (Amendment No. 2)
Rules 1968

Made 16th December 1968

Coming into Operation 16th December 1968

In pursuance of the powers conferred on me by Schedule 5 to the Criminal Justice Act 1948(a) and section 1 of the Police, Fire and Probation Officers Remuneration Act 1956(b), I hereby make the following Rules :—

1. In Rule 4(1) of the Probation (Conditions of Service) Rules 1965(e) for the figure “£75” (which was substituted by the Probation (Conditions of Service) (No. 3) Rules 1965(d)), there shall be substituted the figure “£90”.

2.—(1) These Rules may be cited as the Probation (Conditions of Service) (Amendment No. 2) Rules 1968.

(2) These Rules shall come into operation forthwith and shall take effect from 1st May 1968.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Rules.)

These Rules amend the Probation (Conditions of Service) Rules 1965, as amended, by increasing the London addition payable to certain probation officers from £75 to £90. By virtue of section 1 of the Police, Fire and Probation Officers Remuneration Act 1956 the Rules take effect from 1st May 1968.
