SUGAR

The Sugar (Surcharge Remission) Order 1968

Made - - - 18th December 1968
Laid before Parliament 30th December 1968
Coming into Operation 31st December 1968

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food (hereinafter referred to as "the Minister") in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 58 of the Finance Act 1968(a) construed as one with the Sugar Act 1956(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, for the purpose of prescribing such goods as it appears to him to be expedient to prescribe for the purposes of subsection (1)(b) of that section in the interests of the national economy, hereby makes the following order:—

- 1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Sugar (Surcharge Remission) Order 1968; and shall come into operation on 31st December 1968.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of this order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 2. Goods of the descriptions specified in the Schedule to this order are hereby prescribed for the purposes of subsection (1)(b) of section 58 of the Finance Act 1968 (which authorises the Commissioners of Customs and Excise to remit or repay surcharge under section 7 of the Sugar Act 1956 if they are satisfied that the sugar in respect of which it is payable or has been paid will be, or has been, used in the manufacture of goods of any description prescribed for the above mentioned purposes, at the time when the sugar was or is so used, by an order made by the Minister).
