Whereas a draft of the following Order in Council has been laid before Parliament and approved by resolution of each House of Parliament:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in pursuance of section 1(2) of the Armed Forces Act 1966(a), is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

- 1. The Army Act 1955(b) shall continue in force for a period of twelve months beyond the 31st December 1968, that date being the date on which it would otherwise expire.
- 2. This Order may be cited as the Army Act 1955 (Continuation) Order 1968.
