The Lords of Council and Session, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by section 10 of the Public Records (Scotland) Act 1937(a), as amended by section 1(7) of the Public Registers and Records Act (Scotland) 1948(b), and of all other powers competent to them in that behalf, and with the approval of the Treasury, do hereby enact as follows:—

- 1. The fees to be charged in the Scottish Record Office for inspection of records, for copies thereof, and for other services relating thereto shall be those set out in the Schedule to this Act of Sederunt.
- 2. Section 2 of the Act of Sederunt (Amendment of Fees in the Departments of the Registers of Scotland and of the Records of Scotland) 1956(c) and sections 2 and 3 of the Act of Sederunt (Amendment of Fees in the Departments of the Registers of Scotland and of the Records of Scotland) 1962(d) are hereby repealed.
- 3. This Act of Sederunt may be cited as the Act of Sederunt (Amendment of Fees in the Scottish Record Office) 1968 and shall come into operation on the 1st day of February 1969.

And the Lords appoint this Act of Sederunt to be inserted in the Books of Sederunt.
