The Independent Schools Tribunal (Amendment) Rules 1968

Made - - - 9th April 1968
Coming into Operation 25th April 1968

- I, Gerald, Baron Gardiner, Lord High Chancellor of Great Britain, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 75(1) of the Education Act 1944(a), after consultation with the Council on Tribunals in accordance with section 8 of the Tribunals and Inquiries Act 1958(b) and with the approval of the Treasury, do hereby make the following Rules with the concurrence of the Lord President of the Council:—
- 1.—(1) These Rules may be cited as the Independent Schools Tribunal (Amendment) Rules 1968, and shall come into operation on 25th April 1968.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c), shall apply to the interpretation of these Rules as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 2. Paragraph (2) of the Second Schedule to the Independent Schools Tribunal Rules 1958(d) shall be amended as follows:—
 - (a) in sub-paragraph (a) for the figures "5s. 6d." and "12s." there shall be substituted the figures "6s. 6d." and "14s." respectively;
 - (b) in sub-paragraph (b) for the words "48s. 6d. for each night" there shall be substituted the following words:—
 - "(i) for each night spent within 4 miles of Charing Cross, £4 8s.;
 - (ii) for each night spent elsewhere, £4."
