JUVENILE COURTS AND OFFENDERS**The Juvenile Courts (London) Order 1968**

Made - - - - - 9th April 1968

Coming into Operation 1st May 1968

In pursuance of the powers conferred on me by paragraphs 14 and 20 of Schedule 2 to the Children and Young Persons Act 1933(a), as amended by section 17(1) of the Children and Young Persons Act 1963(b) and section 12(1) of the Administration of Justice Act 1964(c), I hereby make the following Order:—

1. In the Schedule to the Juvenile Courts (London) Order 1965(d), as amended(e), for the entry in column 2 relating to the place of sitting of the juvenile court for the South Western London division there shall be substituted the following entry:—

“Anchor Mission,
273, Garratt Lane,
Wandsworth, S.W.18.

The Town Hall,
Municipal Buildings,
Wandsworth, S.W.18.”

2. This Order may be cited as the Juvenile Courts (London) Order 1968 and shall come into operation on 1st May 1968.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends the Juvenile Courts (London) Order 1965 (which assigned divisions and places of sitting to the juvenile courts for the inner London area and the City of London) by adding the Town Hall, Wandsworth in addition to the Anchor Mission, Wandsworth as a place of sitting for the juvenile court for the South Western division.
