## The Dog Racecourse Totalisator (Percentage) Order 1969

Made - - - - 12th November 1969

Coming into Operation 8th December 1969

In pursuance of paragraph 3 of Schedule 5 to the Betting, Gaming and Lotteries Act 1963(a) as amended by section 1 of the Betting, Gaming and Lotteries (Amendment) Act 1969(b), I hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Dog Racecourse Totalisator (Percentage) Order 1969 and shall come into operation on 8th December 1969.

2. A percentage of twelve and a half per cent. is hereby specified for the purposes of sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph 3 of Schedule 5 to the Betting, Gaming and Lotteries Act 1963 as amended by section 1 of the Betting, Gaming and Lotteries (Amendment) Act 1969.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order permits the operator of a totalisator on a dog racecourse to specify up to 12½% (instead of the 6% mentioned in paragraph 3(a) of Schedule 5 to the Betting, Gaming and Lotteries Act 1963) as the percentage he will deduct from the amounts staked.
