**The Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) (Amendment) (No. 2)
Regulations 1969**

The Minister of Transport in exercise of his powers under sections 102 and 113 of the Road Traffic Act 1960^(a) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with representative organisations in accordance with section 260(2) of that Act, hereby makes the following Regulations :—

1.—(1) These Regulations shall come into operation on the 26th November 1969, and may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1969.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889^(b) shall apply for the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. The Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) Regulations 1963^(c), as amended ^(d), shall have effect as though for paragraph (2)^(a) of Regulation 7 there were substituted the following :—

“(a) is undergoing a test or a test of competence to drive heavy goods vehicles under Part V of the Act of 1960 ; or”

3. The provisions of Regulation 7 of the Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) Regulations 1963, as amended by these Regulations, shall apply in relation to a provisional licence granted before the date of coming into force of these Regulations, and in force on that date, as they apply in relation to a provisional licence granted on or after that date.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Motor Vehicles (Driving Licences) Regulations 1963 by permitting the holder of a provisional licence granted under Part II of the Road Traffic Act 1960 to drive a heavy goods vehicle otherwise than under the supervision of a qualified driver when undergoing a test of competence under Part V of that Act.
