FOREIGN COMPENSATION

The Foreign Compensation Commission (Union of Soviet Socialist Republics) (Amendment) Rules Approval Instrument 1969

Whereas the Foreign Compensation Commission have, in exercise of their powers under section 4 of the Foreign Compensation Act 1950(a), made rules of procedure and submitted them to the Lord Chancellor for his approval :

Now, therefore, the Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 4 and 8 of the said Act hereby approves the said rules in the form set out in the Schedule hereto.

This instrument may be cited as the Foreign Compensation Commission (Union of Soviet Socialist Republics) (Amendment) Rules Approval Instrument 1969 and shall come into operation on 14th January 1970.

SCHEDULE

The Foreign Compensation Commission in exercise of their powers under section 4 of the Foreign Compensation Act 1950, hereby make the following Rules:—

1.—(1) These Rules may be cited as the Foreign Compensation Commission (Union of Soviet Socialist Republics) (Amendment) Rules 1969.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply to the interpretation of these Rules as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. The Foreign Compensation Commission (Union of Soviet Socialist Republics) Rules 1969(c) shall be amended by the deletion of the proviso to Rule 33 and the substitution of the following proviso:—

“Provided that the time for completing and delivering to the Commission any relevant application form or appendix referred to in either of the provisos (b) and (c) to paragraph (1) of Rule 7 shall not be extended so as to expire more than two months after 31st December 1969 except by leave of not less than two Commissioners which shall not be granted unless they are satisfied that it was not reasonably practicable for the form or appendix to be delivered to the Commission within such time.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Rules.)

These Rules amend the proviso to rule 33 of the Foreign Compensation Commission (Union of Soviet Socialist Republics) Rules 1969 to enable two Commissioners to extend the time for delivering full particulars of claims for compensation so that it will expire more than two months after 31st December 1969 if they are satisfied that it was not reasonably practicable for the particulars to be delivered earlier.
