EDUCATION, SCOTLAND**The Teaching Council (Scotland) Act 1965**
(Amendment of Constitution of the Council) Order 1969

Made - - - - - *21st April 1969*

Coming into Operation *30th April 1969*

In the exercise of the powers conferred on me by paragraph 6 of Schedule 1 to the Teaching Council (Scotland) Act 1965(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, and after consultation with the General Teaching Council and other bodies who appear to me to be concerned, I hereby make the following order:—

1. This order may be cited as the Teaching Council (Scotland) Act 1965 (Amendment of Constitution of the Council) Order 1969 and shall come into operation on 30th April 1969.

2. In Schedule 1 to the Teaching Council (Scotland) Act 1965:—

- (a) in paragraph 4(1) there shall be added at the end:—
“save that in respect of the initial membership of the Council the period of office shall be four years six months.”; and
- (b) in paragraph 5(3) after the word “years” there shall be inserted:—
“or, as the case may be, four years six months”.
