**The Anti-Dumping (Provisional Charge to Duty) Order 1968
(Revocation) Order 1969**

The Board of Trade in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by sections 1, 2 and 11(1) of the Customs Duties (Dumping and Subsidies) Act 1957(a), as extended by the Customs Duties (Dumping and Subsidies) Amendment Act 1968(b), hereby make the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Anti-Dumping (Provisional Charge to Duty) Order 1968 (Revocation) Order 1969 and shall come into operation on 22nd January 1969.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament and as if this Order and the Order hereby revoked were Acts of Parliament.

2. The Anti-Dumping (Provisional Charge to Duty) Order 1968(d) (which imposed a provisional charge to duty on rape seed originating in Poland or the Soviet Zone of Germany) is hereby revoked.
