LOCAL GOVERNMENT, SCOTLAND

The Rate Support Grant (Scotland) (Amendment) Regulations 1969

Made - - - 5th May 1969
Laid before Parliament 15th May 1969
Coming into Operation 16th May 1969

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by paragraph 5 of Part 1 of Schedule 1 to the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1966(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, and after consultation with such associations of local authorities as appear to me to be concerned, I hereby make the following regulations:—

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Rate Support Grant (Scotland) (Amendment) Regulations 1969 and shall come into operation on 16th May 1969.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. The Rate Support Grant (Scotland) Regulations 1967(c) as amended by the Rate Support Grant (Scotland) (Amendment) Regulations 1968(d) shall be further amended as follows:—

In paragraph (7) of regulation 4 there shall be added after the words "health visitors" the words ", district nurses,".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Regulations further amend the existing Regulations dealing with the pooling (by means of adjustments to rate support grants) of expenditure incurred by certain local authorities among all local authorities, by adding expenditure on the training of district nurses to the items of expenditure to be pooled.
