CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

**The Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment No. 6)
Order 1970**

Made - - - - - 23rd July 1970
Coming into Operation 24th July 1970

The Board of Trade, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 1 of the Import, Export and Customs Powers (Defence) Act 1939(a) hereby order as follows:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment No. 6) Order 1970, and shall come into operation on 24th July 1970.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. The Export of Goods (Control) Order 1967(c), as amended(d), shall have effect as if—

(a) there were added, as sub-paragraph (ii) of paragraph (j) of Article 2(1), the following:—

“ (ii) live cattle, sheep and swine from Northern Ireland to the Republic of Ireland ; ” ; and

(b) there were added, as paragraphs (l) and (m) of Article 2(1), respectively, the following:—

“ (l) meat, fresh, chilled or frozen (including edible offal) of bovine animals, sheep and swine, from Northern Ireland ; ”

“ (m) dead poultry (that is to say, fowls, ducks, geese, turkeys and guinea fowls), fresh, chilled or frozen (including edible offal), from Northern Ireland.”

 EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order further amends the Export of Goods (Control) Order 1967. Export control is removed from exports of live cattle sheep and swine from Northern Ireland to the Republic of Ireland, and from exports of meat of bovine animals, sheep and swine, and of dead poultry, from Northern Ireland to any destination other than Southern Rhodesia.
