The Customs (Import Deposits) (No. 2) Order 1970

Made -

7th August 1970

Laid before the House of Commons

13th August 1970

Coming into Operation

1st September 1970

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury, by virtue of the power conferred on them by section 1(11) of the Customs (Import Deposits) Act 1968(a) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Customs (Import Deposits) (No. 2) Order 1970.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
 - (3) This Order shall come into operation on 1st September 1970.
- 2. The amount of the import deposit payable in respect of any goods by virtue of section 1(1) of the Customs (Import Deposits) Act 1968 as amended by section 1(1) of the Customs (Import Deposits) Act 1969(c) and the Customs (Import Deposits) Order 1970(d) (which was made under the powers of section 1(11) of the said Act of 1968 and reduced the import deposit so payable from forty per cent. to thirty per cent.) is hereby reduced from thirty per cent. to twenty per cent.

This Order reduces to 20 per cent. the amount of import deposit payable on imported goods entered with the Customs on or after 1st September 1970.
