**The Administration of Justice Act 1970
(Commencement No. 2) Order 1970***Made* - - - *3rd August 1970*

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 54(4) of the Administration of Justice Act 1970(a), hereby makes the following Order :—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Administration of Justice Act 1970 (Commencement No. 2) Order 1970.

(2) In this Order “the Act” means the Administration of Justice Act 1970.

(3) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply to this Order as it applies to an Act of Parliament.

2. The provisions of the Act specified in the Schedule to this Order shall come into operation on 1st September 1970.

Schedule 11 so far as it relates to section 4(3) of the Maintenance Orders Act 1958 and to the Maintenance Orders Act 1968(b)	Enactments repealed.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order brings into operation on 1st September 1970 section 48 and related provisions of the Administration of Justices Act 1970. That section will permit a magistrates' court in which a maintenance order is registered for enforcement to vary upwards the rate of payments specified in the order.
