CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

The Export of Goods (Control) Order 1970 (Amendment) Order 1970

Made - - - - 29th December 1970 Coming into Operation 4th January 1971

The Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under section 1 of the Import, Export and Customs Powers (Defence) Act 1939(a), hereby orders as follows:—

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Export of Goods (Control) Order 1970 (Amendment) Order 1970 and shall come into operation on 4th January 1971.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
 - 2. The Export of Goods (Control) Order 1970(c) shall have effect as if—
 - (a) in Schedule 1, Group 5, in the entry relating to Aluminium, for "£200" in head (2) and "£100" in head (3) there were substituted, respectively, "£300" and "£130"; and

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends the Export of Goods (Control) Order 1970.

- 1. The export of certain aluminium goods has hitherto been controlled if their value has not exceeded the value, calculated at £200 per ton, of the aluminium and aluminium alloys contained in the goods; and the export of certain aluminium foil has been controlled if its value has not exceeded £100 per ton. These amounts are increased to £300 and £130 respectively.
 - 2. The export of pork is no longer controlled.
