**The Wireless Telegraphy (Broadcast Licence Charges)
Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 1970**

The Minister of Posts and Telecommunications, with the consent of the Treasury, in the exercise of his powers under section 2 of the Wireless Telegraphy Act 1949(a), by the said section as extended to the Channel Islands by the Wireless Telegraphy (Channel Islands) Order 1952(b) and by the said section as extended to the Isle of Man by the Wireless Telegraphy (Isle of Man) Order 1952(c), and of every other power enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations :

Commencement, citation and interpretation

1.—(1) These Regulations shall come into operation on the 25th February 1970 and may be cited as the Wireless Telegraphy (Broadcast Licence Charges) Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 1970.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply for the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Issue and Annual Fees

2. The Wireless Telegraphy (Broadcast Licence Charges) Regulations 1967(e) as amended (f) shall be further amended as follows :—

by substituting in Regulation 5 thereof for the words “1st January” the words “1st August” and by substituting for Schedule 2 thereof the Schedule hereto.

In this Schedule, the expression "sound programmes" means programmes intended for general reception in sound only, and the expression "television programmes" means programmes intended for general reception in visual images with or without sound.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations further amend the Wireless Telegraphy (Broadcast Licence Charges) Regulations 1967, by increasing the issue and annual fees payable on Broadcast Relay Station Licences.
