The Price Stability of Imported Products (Rates of Levy No. 3) Order 1970

Made 25th February 1970 Coming into Operation ... 26th February 1970

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 1(2), (4), (5), (6) and (7) of the Agriculture and Horticulture Act 1964(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

- 1. This order may be cited as the Price Stability of Imported Products (Rates of Levy No. 3) Order 1970, and shall come into operation on 26th February 1970.
 - 2.—(1) In this order—

"the Principal Order" means the Price Stability of Imported Products (Levy Arrangements) Order 1966(b) as amended(c) and as amended by any subsequent order, and if any such order is replaced by any subsequent order the expression shall be construed as a reference to such subsequent order:

AND other expressions have the same meaning as in the Principal Order.

- (2) The Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply to the interpretation of this order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament and as if this order and the order hereby revoked were Acts of Parliament.
- 3. In accordance with and subject to the provisions of Part II of the Principal Order (which provides for the charging of levies on imports of certain specified commodities)—
 - (a) the rate of general levy for such imports into the United Kingdom of any specified commodity as are described in column 2 of Part I of the Schedule to this order in relation to a tariff heading indicated in column 1 of that Part shall be the rate set forth in relation thereto in column 3 of that Part;
 - (b) the rate of country levy for such imports into the United Kingdom of any specified commodity as are described in column 2 of Part II of the Schedule to this order in relation to a tariff heading indicated in column 1 of that Part shall be the rate set forth in relation thereto in column 3 of that Part.
- 4. The Price Stability of Imported Products (Rates of Levy No. 2) Order 1970(e) is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This order, which comes into operation on 26th February 1970, supersedes the Price Stability of Imported Products (Rates of Levy No. 2) Order 1970. It—

- (a) fixes a rate of country levy of 70s. per ton on imports of barley groats, barley meal, kibbled or cut barley, rolled, flaked, crushed or bruised barley and other processed barley which, in each case, is a product of the Netherlands and has been consigned to the United Kingdom from that country; and
- (b) reimposes unchanged the other rates of general and country levies in force immediately before the commencement of this order.
